

The board may establish a district web site and may allow creation of web sites for individual schools. A district web site shall be under the control of the superintendent and school web sites shall be supervised by the principal.

Web Site Rules

Detailed rules relating to web sites are found in appropriate handbooks or in documents approved by the board and filed with the clerk and/or principals.

School rules shall include the following areas:

- data privacy and FERPA regulations; (See JRB)
- copyright rules, relating to access and use of materials and the property rights of the district, students or employees who create material; (See ECH and IIBG)
- board and administration shall determine web site content and monitor use by employees and students.

District and school web sites are maintained to support the public relations and educational programs of the district and/or the schools.

Web sites may be modified or terminated at any time by board action.
